# Therapeutic Responsibilities

Your main duties and responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Practice outcome focused, evidence-based counselling sessions, to members of the LGBTQIA+ community in accordance with the Rainbow Mind, therapeutic model.
- Work in partnership with the Therapy Service Manager to support members of the LGBTQIA+ community experiencing mild to moderate mental health difficulties.
- Book appointments via the Case Management System.
- Practice, evidence and demonstrate an ability to manage caseload in conjunction with the requirements of the team.
- Keep clear and professional records, that are coherent and in line with Mind in Salford's policies and procedures.
- Complete all requirements relating to data collection.
- Always operate from an inclusive standpoint, recognising and respecting diversity, maintaining a particularly strong focus on a range of diversity issues impacting upon the LGBTQIA+ community specifically and with a strong focus on intersectionality.
- Undertake and record accurate assessments of risk and operate clear risk management process in line with agreed procedures that speak to Mind in Salford's safeguarding policies and procedures.
- Record thorough session notes to the case management system after each session, highlighting areas of risk specifically.
- Adhere to all of Mind in Salford's policies and procedures.
- Use a range of monitoring and assessment tools, including, but not limited to the PHQ9, GAD7 and the Self-Compassion Scale.



## **Professional Responsibilities**

- Ensure the maintenance of professional standards in accordance with Mind in Salford Policies and Procedures.
- Ensure that Confidentiality is also maintained and protected.
- Ensure that any risks, and or safeguarding concerns, are promptly reported to the relevant parties in order to maintain individuals' safety.
- Participate in communicating updates with the Rainbow Mind Therapy Service Manager.
- Keep continuous professional development and theoretical knowledge up to date to be able to support the needs of the LGBTQIA+ community, with specific focus on Compassion Focused Therapy.
